POTENTIAL JOINT VENTURE WITH SMME'S ON THE CURRENT CATERING MANAGEMENT OF SEVEN MANAGEMENT AREAS, OR POTENTIAL ACQUISITION.

We refer to the meeting conducted with representatives of Crearis, as well as the correspondence by shareholders Tsepo Motlatsi and Nozuko Mani.

The Department of Corrections welcomes the initiative as presented and will oblige to further discussions in this regard, provided that a seamless transition takes place with no adverse effect on the current contract obligations.

In terms of a Joint Venture and the Subcontracting of the management of the services currently provided to the Department, the Company will have to validate that it is in fact a SMME, and complies with the minimum BEE requirements set forth in terms of ownership of the entity. No other requirements would be required.

In terms of a complete purchase of the contract, the entity would have to ensure that it complies with the standards as set by the contractual requirements of the Department in the Bid document, and would require approval from the Bid Adjudication Committee, such approval will not be unreasonably withheld.

The Department however welcomes new entrants especially SMME companies, and appreciates African Global's initiative to further Governments call to empower young emerging entrants.
